Dine to Donate Sundays

Want an easy way to donate money to St. Stephen Lutheran Church? Just eat at Texas Roadhouse in Wausau on Sundays!!! This is how it works: dine at Texas Roadhouse on Sunday and present our church bulletin for 10% of your food bill (not including alcohol, taxes, or gratuity) to be donated back to our church. Not valid with any other offers or on holidays. Dine in ONLY. One per table, per visit. This is a weekly, on-going program that takes place EVERY Sunday. A check will be sent to the church once a month. It's that simple!!! So, go enjoy a great meal and give back to St. Stephen.

HELP Closet

What is HELP Closet? It is our local Health Equipment Lending Program. Items usually available are: hospital beds, wheelchairs, commodes, shower seats, standard walkers, canes, and crutches. There is a minimal charge to use an item from this closet. For instance, to rent a wheelchair short term (6 months) is \$30. To purchase is \$100. The closet is located at 1106 Fifth Street in Wausau, 715-843-5985.

Quilting Supplies Needed

We are in need of the following supplies for Lutheran World Relief Quilting:

1. <u>Flat sheets</u> – Any size or color (preferably not white), clean, free of stains, and no holes

2. <u>Fabric</u> – Any size or color (big enough for our Quilters to cut 6" squares or larger)

3. <u>Mattress Pads, Blankets, etc.</u> – Any size or color, as long as they are clean/washed

4. Thread & Yarn - Any color

If you would like to donate to this cause, bring your items to church and place them in the Nursery (at the end of the hall; last door on left). You may continue placing quilting supplies in this location throughout the year. Thank you in advance for your help!

St. Stephen Trust Fund

St. Stephen Lutheran Church established a Trust Fund in 1988 as an investment in our future. There are two funds invested through Vigil Trust and Financial Fiduciary in Wausau. The Trust Fund Committee is responsible for these funds and uses only a percentage of the earnings for the designated projects. The Wider Mission Fund is to support the wider mission of the Church in our community and globally. Examples would include: The Neighbors' Place, Faith in Action, Open Door, the Wausau Warming Center, Homeless Kids Fund, Lutheran World Relief, and others. The Building Preservation Fund is for the preservation of our church buildings. In the past this has included fixing the elevator, parsonage updates, and organ repair as well as other repair projects. St. Stephen is known for its generosity. Because only the interest earned on each fund is used in our outreach missions, it is important to maintain a solid investment balance. Please keep the St. Stephen Trust Fund in mind when doing your estate planning. You can designate a specific fund or project, or make a general reference to the Trust Fund.

Benevolence

Through your support of St. Stephen in the month of May 2022, we were able to contribute to the following ministry:

ELCA National & Synod Support \$601

This is the third month of our unified budget in which we now give four and one half percent (4.5%) of our current expense receipts and loose plate offerings for benevolence. The above amount is based on the income of \$13,353 for May.

COUNCIL MINUTES ~ JUNE 14, 2022

The meeting opened at 5:35 pm with a devotion provided by Chuck.

Present: Kathy Robinson, Shauna Robinson, Lloyd Zimmel, Pat Erdman, Verlyn Oelke, Pam Hackbart, and Jeff Blomquist. Online: Chuck Johnson and Sarah Lonsdorf.

A motion was made and passed to accept the May 10, 2022 Council minutes.

A motion was made and passed to accept the May 31, 2022 Special Council minutes where we worked on our compensation offer for our prospective Pastoral Candidate.

Pastor's Report: No report was provided.

President's Report: A written report was provided.

Treasurer's Report: A written report was provided. We have \$27,899 in our General Fund.

A motion was made and carried to accept these two reports.

Committee Reports:

Education/Youth: Education Elder is on a one year substitution by Member at Large.

Good Stewards: No written report was provided.

Property: A written report was provided. It looks like roof repair is in our future.

Worship: A written report was provided. They have had interest in the Director of Music opening; see "New Business" below.

Trust Fund: A written report was provided. Our funds were down in May. Trust approved two donations: one to Crossways and another to Faith in Action. Thank-you cards have come in from those who received previous donations.

A motion was made and carried to accept these reports.

Old Business:

- Memorial Fund Review There is no change to the priority order this month. Technology Fund is still number one, Current Expense
 Fund is number two, and Sustainability Trust Fund is number three.
- In-person worship will continue, we ask you mask as you are comfortable and please watch online if you are ill. Pew ropes have been
 removed, but we ask that you continue to distance from others and be mindful of those who have masked and may have
 compromised health issues. Communion will continue as is for the time being. Please continue to be mindful of your church family.
- Transition update: A Congregational Meeting has been called for Sunday, June 26th following our 9 am service to approve the candidate chosen by our Call Committee.
- A motion was made and carried to offer the Director of Music position to Delores Kessel at a monthly stipend of \$200.
- We tabled the discussion on our Wedding Policy updates.
- The Parsonage Lease Extension is pending. No decision has been made.
- Little Scholars is looking to extend their contract with us. We are still working with them to figure out terms. They are currently up to date on their rent.
- A new computer has been purchased for Bill, Nancy's is on hold, and if we call a new pastor, one will be ordered to fill their needs.
- We continued our discussion on how to proceed doing nominations as a Council in the coming year.
- There will be no updates to our Constitution at this time.
- We will be working on a Mutual Ministry Committee if the Call for our Pastor is approved. Some members of the Call Committee have volunteered to be part of the Mutual Ministry Committee on an interim basis.
- We are still working on our updated Funeral Meal Policy.
- We are looking for additional people to be Sunday Custodians.

New Business:

- A motion was made and carried to approve May bills.
- Shauna and Kathy Robinson attended the Synod Assembly on our behalf. Kathy gave a brief report on the assembly. There will be a written report posted on the hallway bulletin board.
- Staff meeting report Kathy shared some items talked about at the meeting. It was suggested that we look at some sort of welcome meal to introduce the congregation to our new pastor if they are approved. A reminder that Nancy will be on vacation from June 24th July 4th.
- A motion was made and carried to approve the transfer of Ron and Sally Kleppen to Mt. Olive Lutheran.

We usually do not meet in July, but have a tentative meeting scheduled for Tuesday, July 12th at 5:30 pm if needed, with Chuck providing devotions.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:45 pm with the Lord's Prayer.
