

COUNCIL MINUTES ~ JULY 12, 2023

Present: Pastor Karoline, Lloyd Zimmel, Verlyn Oelke, Jim Von Rueden, Sue Holster, Shauna Robinson, Pam Hackbart, Kathy Robinson, Vicki Romang, Sarah Lonsdorf, and Lynn Deffner.

Absent: Jeff Blomquist and Jacque Schremp.

A motion was made and passed to accept the June 6, 2023, Council minutes.

A motion was made and carried to accept all written reports that were submitted, after brief discussion.

Pastor's Report: No written report was provided.

President's Report: A written report was provided.

Treasurer's Report: A written report was provided. In addition to the written report, we discussed the Balance Sheet and reviewed financial records. There is a balance of \$7,475 in the General Fund. No change in the order of the Memorial Fund at this time.

Invoices: We have seen an increase in the water bill, consistent with the recent hike in water costs by the city of Wausau.

A motion was made and carried to accept these reports.

Committee Reports:

Good Stewards: No written report was provided.

Personnel: A written report was provided.

Property: The Property Committee received an anonymous gift of money to be used towards the new kitchen cabinets in the serving kitchen. A quote was obtained for different cabinet finishes and options. A motion was made and passed to allow the sub-committee to approve the cabinets to be purchased.

Worship: A written report was provided.

Trust Fund: No written report was provided.

A motion was made and carried to accept these reports.

<u>Vitality Survey</u>: A brief discussion was had about the importance of the upcoming Vitality Survey that our congregation will be participating in. We want to ensure that we have the needed resources to keep our congregation healthy and to define who we are and want to be as a congregation.

Shortage of Supply Pastors: Focus then turned to the shortage of supply pastors in the Wausau area, and how we can assist other congregations to carry out their missions.

It was noted that church congregation sizes have been shrinking in the last few years; this could be due to the average size of the family being smaller, people utilizing other means of services (online/television), or generational differences.

It was also noted that many congregations in the area are small and cannot afford a full-time pastor.

We discussed possible solutions to help area congregations and will be reaching out to our Lay Ministers to see if they are able and willing to lead worship in other churches.

Resulting from the discussion, we will also be drafting a letter to send to other congregations to let them know they are welcome to join us at St. Stephen if they do not have a pastor and would like to worship with communion.

We are looking at other ways that we can share in ministry with other congregations without over-extending Pastor Karoline.

Any additional suggestions from our congregation are welcome. Please contact our Council President, Kathy Robinson, with ideas and suggestions.

The next Executive Committee meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 1st at 4:30 pm and the next Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 22nd at 5:30 pm to discuss the results of our Vitality Survey with Pastor Dara from the Synod.
