I've decided on my word of intention for 2025: Explore.

I am writing you for this "February newsletter" on a cold day near the beginning of January. Tomorrow I fly to Greece and



Turkey for a continuing education opportunity. I'm actually tagging along on one of Kathy Robinson's (our resident seminarian) classes. We will be traveling to many of the places in Paul's Epistles in the New Testament, Thessaloniki, Philippi, Corinth, and Ephesus, as well as Athens and Istanbul. We will be exploring ancient places to learn deeply about the contexts that formed early Christianity and the spread of the Gospel.

Exploring ancient contexts and new places is exciting and fun. And exploring will continue long after I arrive home again. Exploration is an ongoing adventure as the Church. We get to listen deeply for where the Holy Spirit is calling us. We get to listen deeply with our ministry partners in the Gospel to meet the need in the world. The fruit of one of these explorations will begin in February. As we discerned the need for responding to grief, we have the opportunity to become a Grief Share site. There will be 13 sessions on Monday nights beginning February 3rd from 6:30-8:30. Help us spread the word as we launch this new ministry here.

I am deeply thankful for the faith to know that God is with us wherever we travel and in all of our explorations.

I will be holding you all in prayer! Many of you have assured me that you will be praying for me as I travel, and I give thanks to God for you all.



Annual Meeting

Community On Call

We have partnered with Good Shepherd in hosting a Community on Call week at Good Shepherd. We are signed up for the week of February 9th thru the 15th. We need volunteers who are willing to stay overnight if it is activated. It could potentially be done in two shifts, but they need people to make it happen. You MUST be 18 years old to volunteer; this is not our rule but the Wausau Police Department for the safety of all involved. It is not a guaranteed need but if you are willing to help and be a body either on call or you can commit, please talk to Shauna Robinson or see the sign-up sheet at the front desk. There will be a training session prior to the on-call week.

Food Drive

For the month of February, the Angels are hosting a food drive to help refill the food panty at First Presbyterian Church (located a couple blocks away). Their pantry is open to the public 3 times a week and serves many in our community. Canned spaghetti sauce and pasta, stuffing mix, instant potatoes, and baked beans are some of the suggested items. COUNCIL MINUTES ~ JANUARY 14, 2025

Present: Sue Holster, Dick Holster, Verlyn Oelke, Vicki Romang, Jeff Blomquist, Sarah Lonsdorf, Shauna Robinson, Darrin Koehler, and Jacque Schremp.

Absent: Pastor Karoline, Kathy Robinson, Nancy Prigge, and Lynn Deffner.

Council Minutes for December 10, 2024: A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes without changes.

<u>Pastor's Report</u>: Pastor Karoline was not able to attend. However, a written report was provided. Confirmation classes are being received well with young people from Good Shepherd and St. Stephen. A Sanctified Art theme was used for Advent and Christmas. Pilgrim, Good Shepherd, and St. Stephen were invited to write prayers on pieces of colored paper which were assembled into paper prayer quilt squares.

<u>President's Report</u>: No written report was provided.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Our General Fund total is \$14,271 and the total capital is \$20,275. The payments for the rental for both Little Scholars and the Parsonage are up to date through December.

A motion was made and carried to accept these reports.

Committee Reports:

Good Stewards: A written report was provided. St. Stephen and Good Shepherd will partner for the Community on Call program, February 9th thru the 15th. This event will be held at Good Shepherd. If you are interested in volunteering for this event, there is a sign-up sheet on the board across from the office. Details were discussed at the last Good Stewards meeting. The Committee also discussed the Homeless Hygiene Drive to be held from February 23rd through March 16th. Donations will be given to the Community Center for Hope, Granite House, Open Door, and The Neighbors' Place. A drive for Coats for Kids will be held again this year starting August 31st and ending on October 26th. The Noisy Offering in January will be given to the Women's Community.

Property: A written report was provided. The heat failed on the second floor. This issue was fixed.

Trust Fund: A written report was provided. Distributions in the month of December totaled \$1,500. Recipients were Stephen's Angels for the Community Food Drive, Bridge Street Mission Hygiene Drive, Catholics Charities Warming Center (January through March), and Peyton's Place.

Worship: No written report provided. The committee did not meet in December.

A motion was made and carried to accept these reports.

Old Business:

• Memorial Fund Order – No change to the order this month. Current Expense Fund is number one, Building Improvement and Maintenance Fund is number two, and Sustainability Trust Fund is number three.

New Business:

- The total amount of invoices paid in December was \$39,776.81.
- Capital Campaign Reminder to congregation contributors of pledges made.
- Audit Committee A committee has been assembled for 2024 audits.
- Candlelight Services The Candlelight services brought many people to our church. There were many good comments made. The group is asking to rent a very small area within the building in order to store their candles.
- Door Labeling A suggestion was made to label the doors throughout the property to provide direction for people that come to attend events in our building.
- Nominating Committee Dick Holster has found volunteers for all open Council positions. Great job, Dick!
- Annual Budget The Agenda for the Annual Meeting was discussed including the budget, election of officers, and reporting.

The next Council meeting will be on Tuesday, February 11, 2025 at 5:30pm.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:05pm.
