# COUNCIL MINUTES ~ SEPTEMBER 9, 2025

**Present:** Dick Holster, Vicki Romang, Jim Von Rueden, Betsy Utecht, Pastor Karoline, Shauna Robinson, Jeff Blomquist, Sarah Lonsdorf, Darrin Koehler, and Nancy Prigge.

**Absent:** Sue Holster, Nelda Hettinga, and Jacque Schremp.

Council Minutes for June 10, 2025: A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes without changes.

<u>Pastor's Report</u>: Pastor Karoline provided a written report. Mary Beth Tolley will be moving to Tennessee at the end of October. There will be a reception in her honor following worship on October 19th.

Treasurer's Report: The General Fund total is \$20,603.52 and the total capital is \$21,349.71.

A motion was made and carried to accept these reports.

#### **Committee Reports:**

**Good Stewards:** A written report was provided. Immanuel has contributed \$1,000 to the Community Outreach Fund. There is a desire to purchase wheeled laundry carts to separate donations intended for different initiatives.

**Property:** Written reports were provided from June and August.

Worship: A written report was provided from the August 4, 2025 committee meeting.

Trust Fund: A written report was provided from the September 7, 2025 committee meeting.

A motion was made and carried to accept these reports.

#### **Old Business:**

• Memorial Fund Order – No change to the order this month. Current Expense Fund is number one, Building Improvement and Maintenance Fund is number two, and Sustainability Trust Fund is number three.

#### **New Business:**

- Invoice Approval—The total amount of invoices paid was \$6,967.66 in June, \$9,522.21 in July, and \$8,110.19 in August. A motion was made and carried to approve the paid invoices.
- Noisy Offering—Sunday, September 21, 2025. Donations from the noisy offerings will continue to be added to the Community Outreach Fund.
- Capital Campaign—St. Stephen is continuing to make double payments.
- Task Force—The Task Force will meet on Tuesday, September 30th at St. Andrew Lutheran Church.
- Wausau Area ELCA Church Presidents' Meeting—The September meeting was postponed until October.
- Candlelight—Six concerts are scheduled for Fall and Winter 2025.
- A motion was made and carried to approve the Trust's transfer in June of \$4,000 to the Pastor's Discretionary Fund from the Wider Mission Fund.
- A motion was made and carried to transfer \$4,000 from the Memorial Reserve Fund to the Pastor's Discretionary Fund.
- Special Congregational Meeting—September 21, 2025. A motion was made and carried to approve the language of a resolution for inclusion on the ballot at the September 21, 2025 special congregational meeting.
- Combined Congregational Retreat—October 26, 2025 at St. Stephen. All congregation members from Pilgrim and St. Stephen are invited to participate.
- Goals for 2025—Review Constitution & Bylaws; review memorial funds; update membership list
- A motion was made and carried to approve the transfer of Everett, Beverly, Nathaniel and Ethan Schmidt to St. John Lutheran Church in the Village of Maine.
- A motion made and carried to approve the transfer of Jeff, Janet, and Harmony Gosch to Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Wausau.
- A motion was made and carried to remove members who have requested removal from the roster.

The next Council meeting will be on Tuesday, October 14, at 5:30 pm.

A motion was made and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:01 pm.

# SPECIAL MTG. MINUTES ~ SEPTEMBER 21, 2025

RE: Potential Merger of Pilgrim Lutheran Church into St. Stephen Lutheran Church

The meeting was called to order by Dick Holster, Council President.

The meeting was held in the sanctuary after church with 45 voting members in attendance, which was a quorum.

The following resolution was presented to the congregation:

<u>Whereas</u>, a merger of Pilgrim Lutheran Church ELCA, 709 Weston Avenue, Wausau, Wisconsin into St. Stephen Lutheran Church ELCA, 512 McClellan Street, Wausau, WI appears to be an avenue that would serve the needs of both congregations and strengthen the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America presence in Wausau, WI and Marathon County, WI, therefore

**<u>BE IT RESOLVED:</u>** That the St. Stephen Lutheran congregation invites Pilgrim Lutheran congregation to enter into conversations to investigate the wisdom of a merger of the two congregations and be it further

**RESOLVED:** That the two congregations direct their transition teams to develop a merger plan to offer to each congregation for study and decision, and be it further

**RESOLVED:** That in this and all matters we ask God's blessing upon our efforts, plans and decisions.

Following discussion, a motion was made and seconded to adopt the resolution as written.

Paper ballots were distributed for voting and were counted by Vicki Romang and Betsy Utecht. The voting result was 43 "Yes" votes in favor of adopting the resolution, 1 "No" vote, and 1 "Abstain."

After the vote, next steps were discussed, including a combined congregational retreat at St. Stephen on Sunday, October 26, 2025, the formation of work groups to address various aspects of the potential merger, and the possible extension of council members' terms until an ultimate decision regarding a merger is made.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
